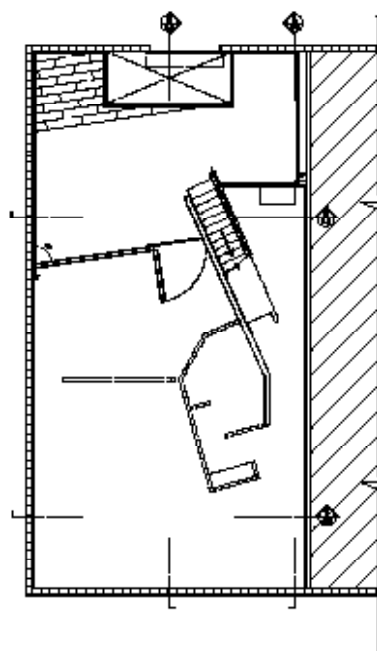
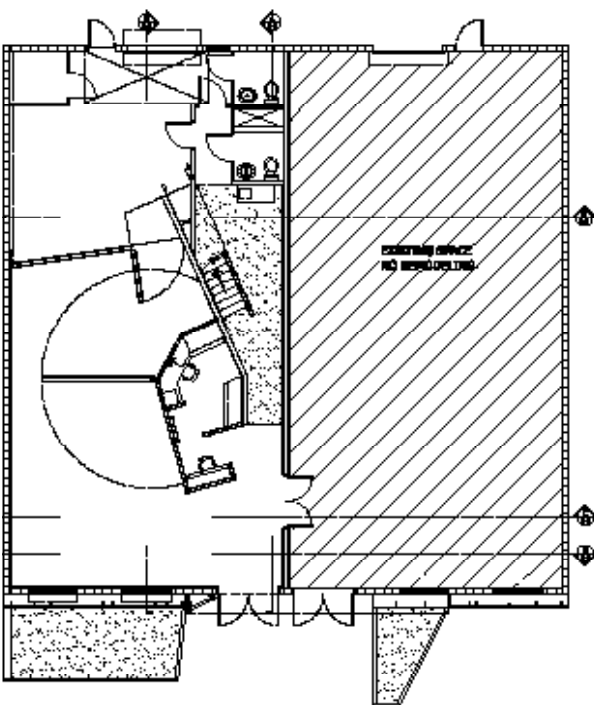

GIRLS' CLUB

The girls' club is an interactive gallery and research center in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. Converting an existing warehouse through the layering of materials, light and movement, the architects create an art-oriented environment for the Bishop Good and Horvitz collection. The exterior façade transforms the building into a scrim and projection screen at night. The interior provides multiple zones with a central pivoting wall and raised mezzanine for interior projection. Color is used selectively to orchestrate patrons visually through different zones.
